John Anderson announces the release of the "Contract with the Citizens of Congressional District 10".

ENON, OHIO-13 January 2012-John Anderson, Republican Party candidate for Congress, OH-10th, today released his formal contract with the citizens of the Ohio 10th Congressional District. The contract is a 25 point policy commitment plan on what Mr. Anderson will do if elected to Congress. Mr. Anderson's contract is also offered as a direct challenge to the other candidates for Congress (including current Congressman Mike Turner) from the 10th Congressional District to formally announce their policy position commitments prior to the primary election on 6 March 2012 for citizen review, comparison, and analysis.

The contract begins with Mr. Anderson's commitment to passage of balanced budget and term limits constitutional amendments which would completely transform American national politics. It contains his support for passage of the Fair Tax Act to stimulate the U.S. economy to produce millions of new jobs and raise the standard of living for all Americans. It concludes with Mr. Anderson's solemn commitment not to personally profit during his term in office coupled with an open formal public verification review process of his personal financial records.

Mr. John Anderson's thirty five year career as a civilian Air Force acquisition manager and contractor consultant embraces the military values of Integrity First, Service Before Self, Excellence In All We Do, and Getting The Job Done. Mr. Anderson's contract is presented and offered to the citizens of the 10th District in accordance with those eternal values before they vote. Mr. Anderson believes that the citizens of the United States should demand that future candidates for high office across the nation should be required to offer similar contracts (emphasizing those values) with the citizens they hope to represent prior to primary and general elections as a new permanent national standard for American politics.
