Incident Information

Description: On January 25, 2018 The Dunbar Wolverines boys were playing the Belmont Bison's in a basketball game. I SRO Anthony P. Jackson Jr. was standing right behind the Dunbar bench in between the spectators stands. As I was standing there closer to the end of the game. I notice a female (Parent of [redacted]) come over to the bench of players and coaches angry and upset that the coach took her son out the game. She was directing all her comments towards Coach Taylor. Ms. Phillips (Dunbar Principal) grab the parents shirt as her was sitting down directly behind the players. At that moment as the parent was pointing her finger and fussing at Coach Taylor he in return turned around and cussed back at her calling her a bitch and directing her to sit down. At that moment player [redacted] stood up, as I was grabbing [redacted] was pushing [redacted] ack, [redacted] then swung at Coach Taylor, I then grabbed [redacted] and escorted him towards the locker room halfway where we was met by his father, Athletic Director Mark Barker, Administrative staff of Dunbar. [redacted] was then escorted to the lock room to grab his belongings and escorted to his mother's car by myself.

- A written reprimand is being placed within the file of Charles Taylor due to the incident on January 26, 2017. The incident involved parent, Sasha Maddox- Craver and the Charles Taylor on sideline. Verbal abuse that transpired between these two adults created a hostile environment during the game. There should never be a time when a parent should approach a coach during a game or thereafter, but even in this case Dunbar Staff must handle themselves as professionals. There will be a two game suspension for January 30, 2018, and February 2, 2018.
- Both parents Anthony Craver and Sasha Maddox- Craver are to be trespassed from all remaining Dunbar games, events, as well as Dunbar Early College High School excluding graduation.

On 1-26-18 during our 4th quarter game again Belmont I called a time out with about one minute to go in the regulation game. After I substituted my player [REDACTED] I looked around and was confronted by [REDACTED] mother Sasha Craver screaming obscenities and making threats to me about making the substitution for her son as she was standing right behind the bench. A few words were exchanged between the two of us, and then out of the corner of my eye I realized [REDACTED] lunges a punch in my direction.

In turn I composed myself to finish coaching the game that was in progress. I am assuming [REDACTED] was in disarray of what was going on and defending his mother at the same time.

My staff and myself have been confronted and harassed by the Craver Family all season long. Via text..phone calls..verbally during/after practices and basketball games. Which led us to close practices to parents/spectators.

It started with the opening city game against Meadowdale where Mr.Craver was asked to leave the locker room after entering without permission to see any coaching staff. He then proceeded to wait about 30 minutes until we left the locker room and I attempted to get on the bus.

Where I was confronted by him and advised him once again to contact me on the next day when the time was appropriate. Our staff has been very patient with these situation's and the Craver family since the beginning of the season.

It is with regret that this written reprimand is being placed within your file due to the incident on January 26, 2017. The incident involved parent, Sasha Maddox- Craver and the sideline Verbal Abuse that transpired between the two of you. There should never be a time when a parent should approach a coach during a game or thereafter, but even in this case Dunbar Staff must handle themselves as professionals.

Mr. Taylor in the Dayton Public Schools Athletic Handbook it states: Our goal is to not only be successful in our endeavors, but also to act according to the ideals of both good sportsmanship and good conduct on and off the court. Our program should operate with: integrity, honor, respect, and accountability. The use of the word "Bitch" to refer to a parent regardless of the situation showed a disrespect for women and our parents in which the Dunbar Varsity Team and the Dayton Community witnessed. This sets a poor example for the young men under your leadership.

Due to the severity of this incident I am imposing a two game suspension that will be served on Tuesday, January 30, 2018 and Friday, Friday February 2, 2018. Lastly, we cannot always control the actions of our parents but we must control the way we react to them.

Below is my account of what I saw and heard concerning the above persons.

On Friday, January 26, 2018 in the last minutes of the game, Coach Taylor pulled [REDACTED] out of the game after a play. [REDACTED] came to the bench disappointed, but calm. [REDACTED]'s mom stomped to the bench, standing behind it, and began pointing and yelling at Coach Taylor. She yelled, "You took my son out the game....." At that time Mrs. Phillips-Everett, principal and Anthony Jackson Jr. (TJ), SRO rushed to remove mom from the situation.

While they grabbed mom, I heard Coach Taylor yell "Bitch!" at [REDACTED] mom. At that point, [REDACTED] jumped up from his seat, [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED]. Both mom and [REDACTED] were ushered to the locker room.

The coaches and myself directed the team to have a seat. The games resumed.

She was using inappropriate language and waving /pointing at the head coach complaining about him taking her son out of the game. She eventually lunged towards the coach while simultaneously a scuffle happened by the bench. As the scuffle ensued the head coach called the parent a "bitch." While the student stated, "That's my mom" or something to that effect. He became infuriated as his parents were being escorted to the back hallway. The parents continued to be belligerent in the hallway as security and staff were present.

I have been informed that you engaged in conduct that was disruptive during the Dunbar vs. Belmont basketball game held at Belmont High School.

Specifically, on January 26, 2018, you engaged in a verbal confrontation with school staff. This confrontation involved inappropriate and threatening language. These behaviors violate Dayton Public Schools Board Policies KGB and KK as well as the Ohio Revised Code §3313.20(A).

You are hereby advised that you are not to enter onto the premises of any Dayton Public School. This notice includes the buildings, the parking lots, and all other Dayton Board of Education property. Additionally, you are not to attend any Dayton Public School sanctioned athletic event. Should you enter onto the premises without express permission from Crystal Phillips, Principal at Dunbar High School, the Dayton Police Department will be notified and we will consider the filing of criminal charges.
